April 19 Intercede for Christ-followers of Niger, Mali, and Guinea, that they may be unified and strong in the face of increasing persecution, oppression, and violence. (John 15:15-21)

April 20 **He is risen!** Hallelujah! We pray that believers would fearlessly declare the resurrection truth of the Gospel today throughout the nations of French-speaking West Africa. (1 Corinthians 15:1-6)

April 21 *Almighty God, we plead for an end to division and violence in this region. Please raise up leaders who will govern with integrity and wisdom, especially over the diverse tribes of Chad and Sudan.* (Proverbs 29:2)

April 22 Many people of Guinea and Guinea-Bissau are trapped in a culture of drug trafficking, exploitation, and abuse. Pray for God-honoring social change and the protection of the most vulnerable. (Proverbs 14:26-27)

April 23 Senegal's French colonial history created strong resistance to Christian evangelism among the six million Wolof people. *Father, please move the intercessors in this region to persist in prayer for breakthrough.* (Isaiah 40:3-5)

April 24 Pray for the Body of Christ in Togo to be purified as His bride, weeding out syncretism and living out their faith in a way that draws their Muslim and Animist neighbors to Christ. (1 John 3:1-3)

April 25 Ask the Holy Spirit to infuse life and vitality into our West Africa staff when their physical bodies are weary. May they also find rest for their souls in our gentle and humble Jesus. (Matthew 11:28-30)

April 26 As you read today's Scripture, pause to pray for accurate Bible translations in both written and story forms (for the illiterate) in West African heart languages. (Acts 2:5-11)

April 27 Pray for our Executive Director, Andre, as he is in Red Deer Alberta at a partner church to share about the one-third of the world that has not heard about the saving grace of Jesus...yet. (Matthew 9:35-38)

April 28 Pray that our West Africa staff and trained disciples will be living testimonies and role models for the younger generation in word and deed. (Psalm 22:30-31; Colossians 3:16-17)

April 29 Two million Tuareg people in Niger, Mali, and Burkina Faso mix a lukewarm Muslim faith with fear of the spirit world. *God of Glory, show them Your power, awaken their spirits, and break their chains!* (Hebrews 2:14-16)

April 30 Please lift up our West Africa staff as they plan to attend X-222 next month. We need God's favor for visas, safety in travel, and protection over families in their absence. (Psalm 5:11-12)

April 1 Currently, 11 countries make up our French-speaking West Africa region. Travel there in prayer, asking for peace, security, and stability for these diverse, Muslim-dominated lands. (Psalm 46:8-11)

April 2 During the Annual Equipping Event in Côte D'Ivoire this week, program directors will be challenged to continue walking by faith and to "finish with faith." Pray they will "hold onto what they have." (Revelation 3:8,11-12)

April 3 Pray with Sister Celine, Regional Prayer Leader, as she asks the Holy Spirit to illuminate her region with faith in Jesus Christ alone for eternal salvation. *Merci, Jésus; merci, Saint-Esprit!* (John 3:16-21)

April 4 Our Global Disciples staff are fasting and praying today. Join us as we pray for our West Africa team to have God's heart for mission and outreach to the 150 million unreached people there. (Romans 10:13-15)

April 5 Tahir serves in a dual role in Global Disciples and carries a heavy burden in this challenging region. Pray for God's strength and enabling as he plans for the coming year. (Hebrews 13:7,17-18)

April 6 Praise God for a successful Annual Equipping Event season! Let us now pray for revitalized and committed program directors and robust support from the local churches. (Hebrews 6:10-12)

April 7 In our call to love our enemies and pray for our persecutors, pray for the jihadists of Benin and Niger to encounter Jesus and be radically transformed. (Acts 26:9-18)

April 8 Please pray for effective Global Disciples training programs to equip church planters, and God's power to propel them into the least-reached areas in Niger—the homeland of Gabriel, our Head Facilitator. (1 Corinthians 2:4-5)

April 9 Scattered across West Africa live 18 million semi-nomadic Fulani Muslims. There are very few believers among them (less than 1%). May this stronghold be broken in Jesus' Name! (2 Corinthians 10:4-5)

April 10 Pray for trusting relationships and brotherly mentorship to continue to develop between our eight West Africa French Facilitators and their program directors. (Proverbs 27:17)

April 11 Abject poverty in some West African countries leads many to seek harmful or sinful ways to survive instead of trusting God's loving hand. Pray for the Church to respond biblically. (Psalm 68:4-10; 1 John 3:16-18)

April 12 Noam handles the administrative and data management duties for our West Africa French-speaking region. Ask the Holy Spirit to give him everything he needs to fulfill his role for the glory of God. (2 Peter 1:3)

April 13 On this Palm Sunday, we recall our Savior's words as He anticipated His coming sacrifice. May His followers in West Africa love eternal life more than this earthly life as they live out their faith. (John 12:24-26)

April 14 Join us today at 6 PM PST as we lift up our brothers and sisters in West Africa during a special Prayer Call (please click on the link above to join). Let's come together for a powerful time of calling out to the Lord. (Jeremiah 33:3)

April 15 Pray for fruitful connections with West African church clusters that will lead to the wise selection of those who should attend directors' trainings. Lord God, we seek Your counsel and guidance. (2 Timothy 1:13-14)

April 16 *Jesus, we lift up the few believers among 17 million Hausa in seven West African countries. Give Your followers opportunities to share what You have accomplished through the cross and resurrection.* (Romans 4:13-25)

April 17 "Father, forgive them." Jesus paid the gruesome penalty of our sin. Pray for conviction, repentance, and forgiveness for those in Togo who engage in occult practices, child trafficking, and prostitution. (Luke 23:33-37)

April 18 "Today you will be with Me." Even as He hung on the cross, Jesus extended His merciful love to the criminal beside Him. May we demonstrate this same love as we pray for the lost. (Luke 23:39-43)
