Pray for Brazil



May 1 On Corcovado Mountain in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, the statue, Christ the Redeemer, symbolizes the outstretched arms of Jesus. Pray that the hearts of all Brazilians will turn to the Living Savior in faith. (Isaiah 11:10-11)

May 2 As we fast and pray on this First Friday, we ask the Lord to rescue and redeem Brazilians enslaved by crime, drugs, and violence. May this harvest of righteousness draw others to Jesus! (Colossians 1:13-14)

May 3 Gerardo is the Regional Coordinator for the whole Latin America territory. Pray for God's strength and grace in his work and home life—that he would experience God's presence in all areas of life. (1 Timothy 1:12)

May 4 Brazil continues to grow as a mission-sending nation with evangelical Christ-followers at about 25 to 30%! We give all glory to God for building His Church and sending them with power. (Ephesians 1:18-23)

May 5 We believe God hears and answers the prayers of His people! Please pray for more intercessors and prayer partners like you to support the vision and mission in Brazil. (1 John 5:14-15)

May 6 Pray for open doors to unreached indigenous tribes living in Brazil's northern states of Amazonas and Bahia, where laws protecting them from foreign diseases have isolated them from mission efforts. (Romans 15:20-21)

May 7 Facilitator Caio invites you to pray for Luana, a program director equipping disciples to plant churches among indigenous people in South Bahia. Pray for supernatural provision despite their poverty. (2 Corinthians 8:2,9)

May 8 As parents struggle to provide for their families in South America's challenging economies, let us pray with Ana, our Latin America Admin and Data Manager, for God to supply their needs. (Psalm 104:13-15)

May 9 Intercede for all those involved in ministry in Brazil to sit at the feet of Jesus daily, stand firm in God's Word, and walk by the Spirit, not by the flesh, as they serve the King of kings. (Psalm 1:1-3; Galatians 5:16)

May 10 Over 13,000 Satere-Mawe people put their young boys through agonizing rites of passage to become warriors. Stand in the

gap for these children; may their elders be open to the Good News. (Psalm 10:17-18)

May 11 Pray for our Brazil staff to faithfully love and support their spouses and raise their children to know Jesus. Ask our Father to protect them and their families as they travel for work and ministry. (Ephesians 5:25-31)

May 12 Please pray for our Canada Board meeting today. Our Big need is a new Board Chair and at least two new Board members. May our Foundation be blessed for the sake of the Unreached. (Acts 13:1-4)

May 13 *Gracious Father, You bless Your people with abundance. Please supply the resources needed for local sustainability of discipling, equipping, and church planting movements in Brazil.* (2 Corinthians 9:7-15)

May 14 Displaced tribes like the Waimiri-Atroari and Pipipa lack education and skills to survive. Pray for mission collaborations which can teach them marketable skills and share the true hope in Jesus. (James 2:14-16)

May 15 Several National Foundations support Global Disciples trainings around the world. Pray for enthusiastic business partners and the successful completion of all requirements to establish a Brazil foundation. (Proverbs 3:9-10)

May 16 As our Latin American team leaves the X-222 gathering this weekend, pray they will arrive safely home with refreshed hearts and renewed strength. Pray for rest from their labor. (Philemon 1:4-7; Exodus 34:21)

May 17 Brazil's 93,000 Portuguese-speaking Jews have assimilated into the culture and many have intermarried. Yet only 1% know Jesus as Messiah. May God increase this small remnant for His glory! (Romans 11:5-6, 25-27)

May 18 Followers of Jesus in Brazil form a vibrant and diverse church. Pray over church pastors, leaders, and all our staff and directors to be aligned in unity and purpose, so that all will see Jesus in them. (Colossians 2:2-3)

May 19 Like other areas of the world, opposition and attacks against Christian values are increasing in Brazil. Cover our brothers and sisters in prayer. May they be reminded of their ultimate victory in Christ. (1 Corinthians 15:56-58)

May 20 Three churches have been planted among the Quilombolas—descendants of escaped African slaves who formed their own communities. Pray they experience the joy of their spiritual inheritance in Christ. (Galatians 3:26-29)

May 21 There are no known Christians among 6,400 Turks in Brazil. Pray they would grow dissatisfied with their traditional but nominal Muslim faith and turn to the One who quenches spiritual thirst. (John 4:13-14)

May 22 Pray for Brazilian Christians to use their religious freedom, talents, and influence to proclaim Jesus far and wide with a bold, clear, and biblically-sound message, leading to revival and glory to God. (1 Peter 4:10-11)

May 23 We praise God for Brazil's 78 active training programs supported by their local churches. We pray that God will use them to impact and transform their communities spiritually, socially, and culturally. (Matthew 5:13-16)

May 24 Thousands of unreached Gamela people of Maranhão have been losing the brutal battle for their land and way of life. Please pray that they would receive God's merciful invitation to a new life. (Isaiah 55:1-6)

May 25 Pray for our Executive Director, Andre, as he preaches at Greendale MB in Chilliwack, BC today. Pray for many people grasp God's heart for the least reached around the world. (Romans 15:20-21)

May 26 Many of Brazil's one million deaf people identify as Christian, though evangelical numbers are uncertain. Pray for living faith and love to propel them as missionaries to other hearing-impaired people. (2 Corinthians 5:14-16)

May 27 Pray over our Brazil team for perseverance and wisdom to develop creative and effective solutions to ministry challenges, especially as they guide, mentor, and encourage program directors. (2 Thessalonians 3:1-5)

May 28 Intercede for Brazil's children and youth trapped in drug addiction, prostitution, or forced labor. *Jesus, please break the enemy's chains and give these young people a new identity in You.* (Ephesians 5:8-11; 2 Corinthians 5:17)

May 29 Facilitator Isaiah has a heart burdened for the poorest people along the Amazon river. Indeed, 59 million Brazilians live below the poverty line. Pray for them to come to Jesus and feast at the table of the King. (Psalm 22:25-31)

May 30 *Obrigado, Jesus!* Thank you, Jesus—for 58 active church clusters in Brazil who partner with Global Disciples to support our vision for reaching the lost. Pray for continued passion in the next generation. (Psalm 78:1-7)

May 31 Pray for Facilitator Biro, as he prepares for a Global Discipleship Directors Training next month in the Amazon region. *Holy Spirit, we rely on You for the plans, participants, and powerful outreach!* (Romans 8:26-29)
